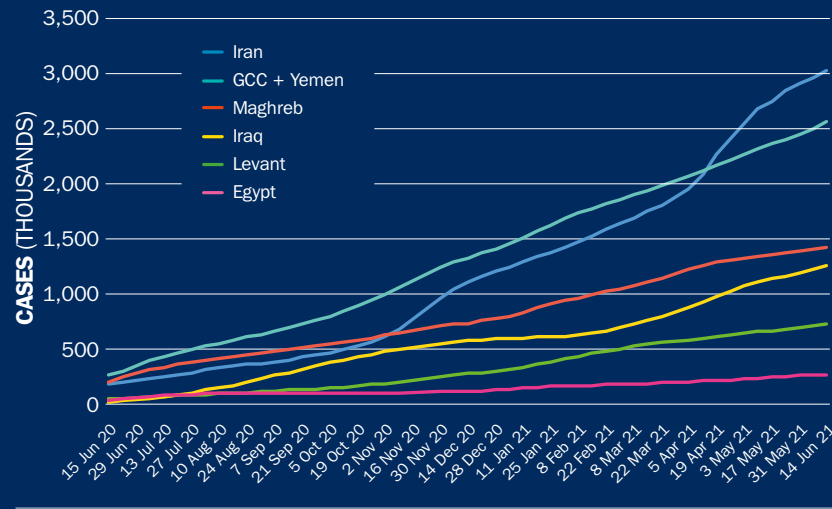


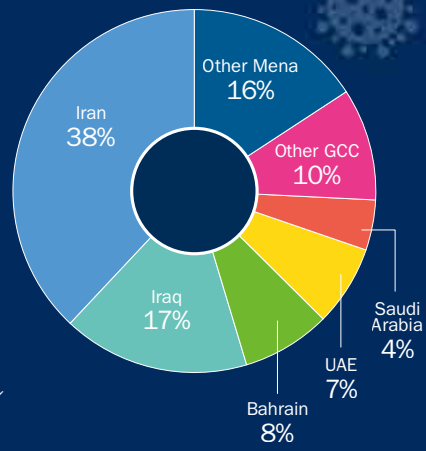

Hajj 2021 will be limited to 60,000 fully vaccinated Saudi citizens and residents amid a steady growth in the number of regional coronavirus cases

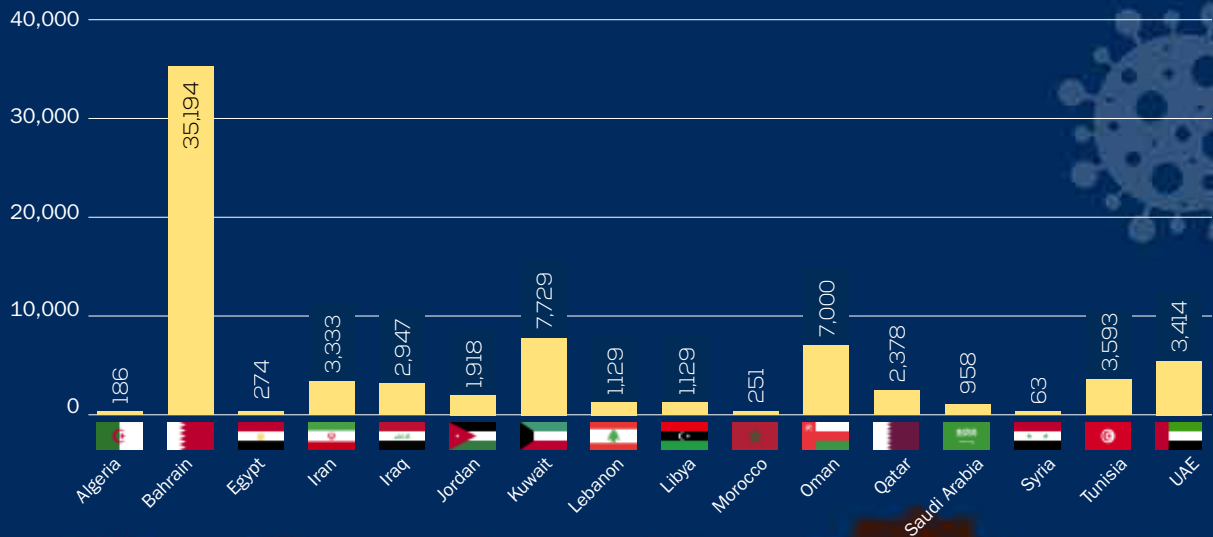
REPORTED COVID-19 CASES IN THE MENA REGION



LATEST FOUR-WEEK CASE COUNT*

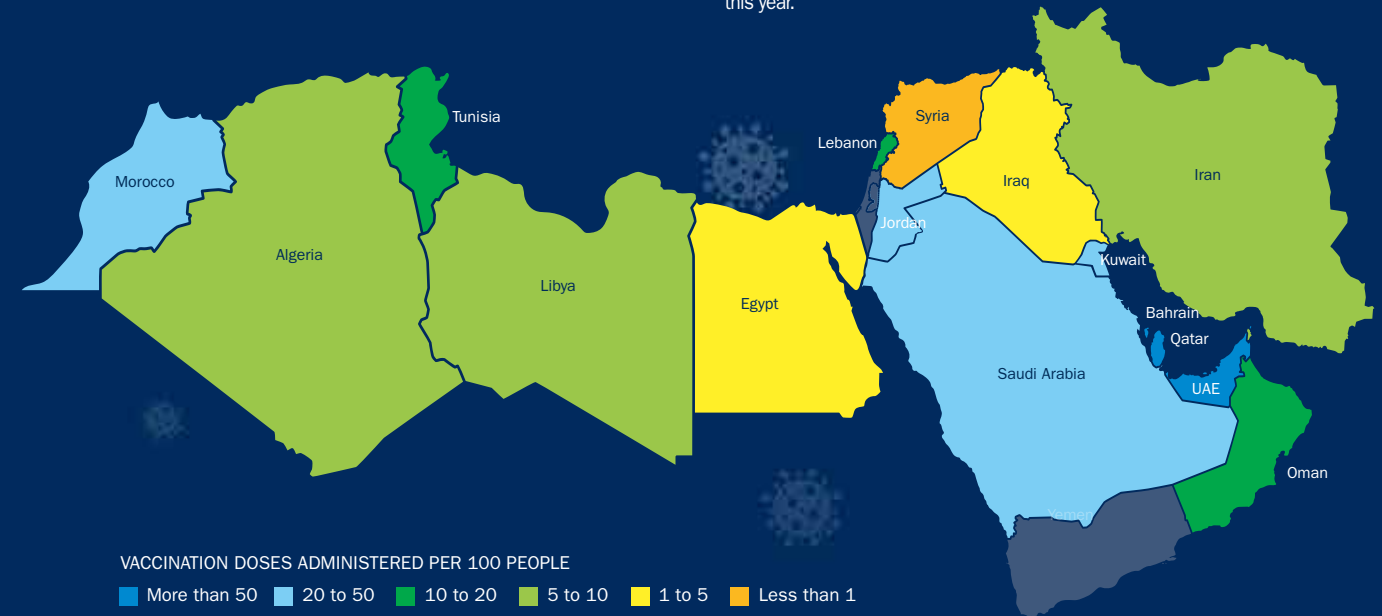


FOUR-WEEK COVID-19 CASE RATE PER MILLION*

Emergency use of Coviran Barekat vaccine, manufactured by the local Shifa Pharmed, is approved.	Government is to restrict access to some services and to international travel to only vaccinated individuals this year.
