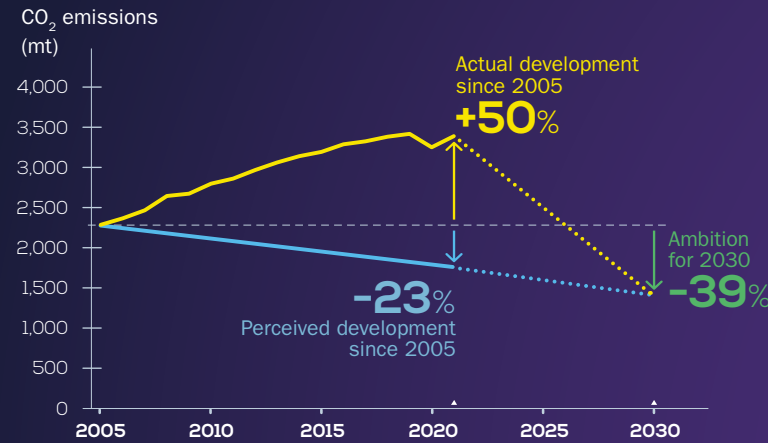


THE GREEN DREAM

Although perceptions of progress on decarbonisation currently outpace actual development, bold projects are in place across the Middle East and Africa to deliver the reality of a green economy

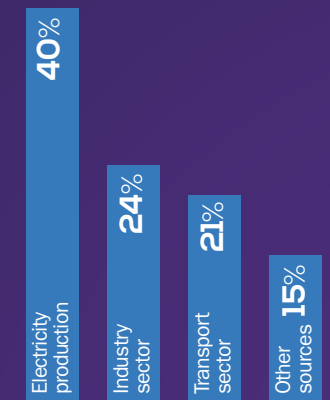
REGIONAL PERCEPTIONS OF CO2 REDUCTION

Perceived progress on emissions is outstripping concrete gains



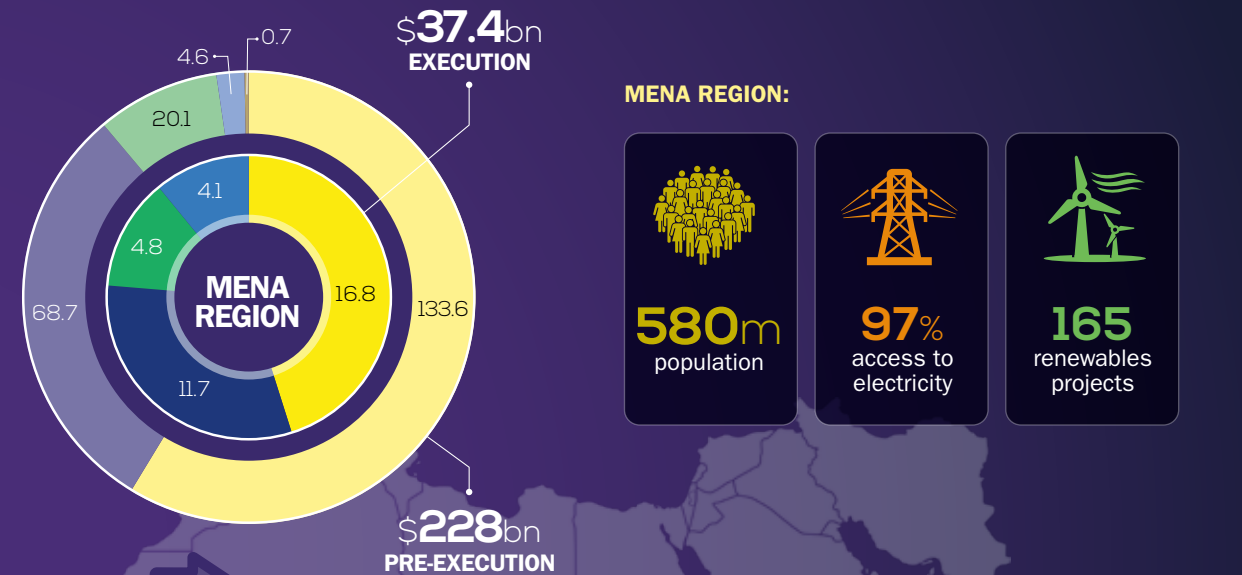
GLOBAL EMISSIONS

Carbon output by sector



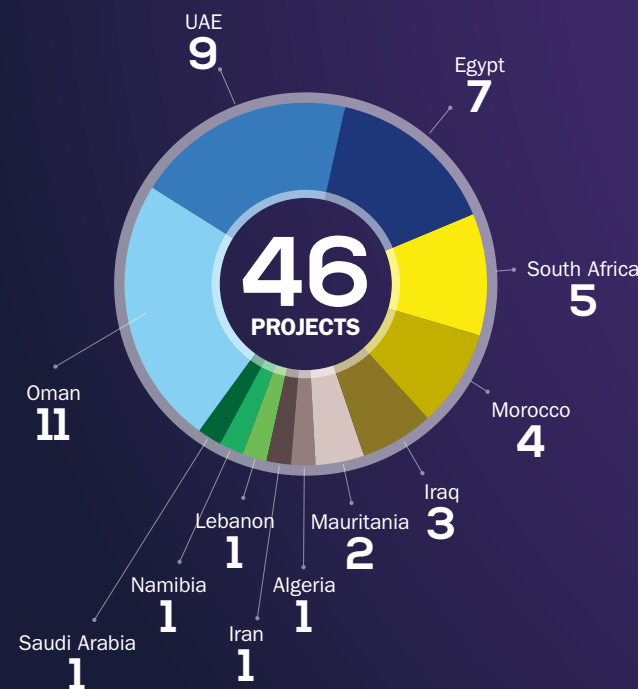
ACTIVE AND PLANNED RENEWABLES PROJECTS

Current energy mix strategies favour solar in the Mena region and hydropower in sub-Saharan Africa



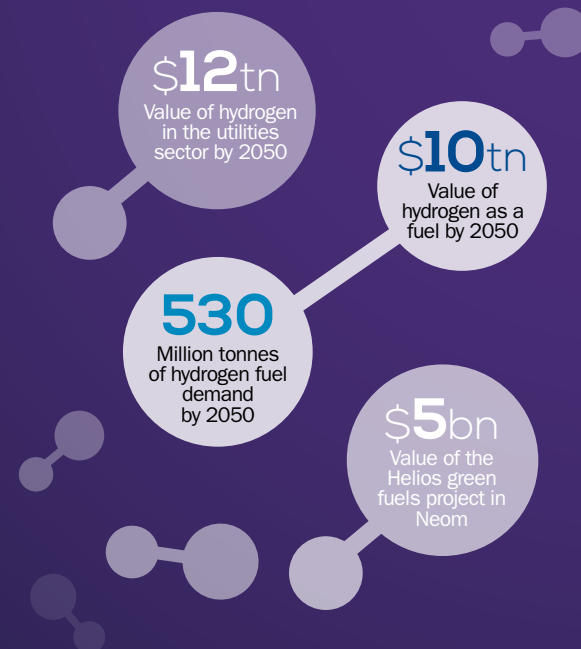
GREEN HYDROGEN PROJECTS
